Class of 2024's graduation requirements will remain the same as the Class of 2023:

English I-10 credits
English II - 10 credits
English III-10 credits
English IV - 10 credits
Math - 30 credits
World History - 10 credits
US History - 10 credits

Government/Economics - $5 / 5$ credits
Physical Science - 10 credits
Biological Science - 10 credits
Foreign Language - 20 credits
Fine Art - 10 credits
Electives - 10 credits
