Due to the increased requirements for graduation in each of the graduation tracks, it is our responsibility to provide adequate time and preparation for our students to choose their graduation track, and to meet the requirements in the track they choose.



Class of 2024's graduation requirements will remain the same as the Class of 2023:

English I - 10 credits
English II - 10 credits
English III - 10 credits
English IV - 10 credits
Math - 30 credits
World History - 10 credits
US History - 10 credits

Government/Economics - 5/5 credits
Physical Science - 10 credits
Biological Science - 10 credits
Foreign Language - 20 credits
Fine Art - 10 credits
Electives - 10 credits

Additional requirements by the State of California:

- 1. Completion of the FAFSA starting with the class of 2023
- 2. Offer a semester course of Ethnic Studies beginning in the 2025-2026 school year
- 3. A semester course of Ethnic Studies Required starting with the Class of 2030
